SCULPTURE AT SCENIC WORLD RESCHEDULED TO 2021

Due to launch in April 2020, Sculpture at Scenic World has been rescheduled to the following year and will now exhibit from April 1 – May 2, 2021.

The decision to postpone the exhibition is in response to the growing concern around COVID-19 and government restrictions that are being put in place for public events.

“Sculpture at Scenic World has over the years become a much-anticipated annual showcase of great artistic talent that brings visitors from far and wide to the Blue Mountains. We are disappointed to postpone the popular event and thank our incredible artists for all their hard work to date. Sculpture at Scenic World is Australia’s premier regional outdoor sculpture exhibition, transforming ancient rainforest into a contemporary outdoor gallery. Its ninth iteration was scheduled to commence on April 9.

Tickets already purchased for Sculpture at Scenic World 2020 will be valid for entry to the 2021 exhibition, Scenic World will follow up directly with all ticket holders.

Scenic World currently remains opens to visitors.
